Background Info

A Photogram does not require a camera or a negative. It is made by placing objects directly on the photo paper and exposing it in the darkroom. Your choice of objects and their arrangement create unique one of a kind prints.



Photogram A

Create a Photogram on a 8 x 11" paper.
Focus on ONE of the following design elements:

- ★ transparency
- ★ reflection
- ★ arrangement
- ★ layering

Remember:

Choose the most interesting objects or substances you can find. Experiment!

Photogram B

Create a Photogram on a 8 x 11" paper.
Focus on creating meaning:
(use ONE of the ideas listed)

- ★ Stage a Scene / tell a story
- ★ Use objects meaningful to you.
- ★ Say something about an issue – something you want to see change in the world or something that bothers you.

Please remember to print and Paste ALL work inside your journal.

This includes test strips and failed attempts. Make sure to communicate which images are your finalized prints.
