

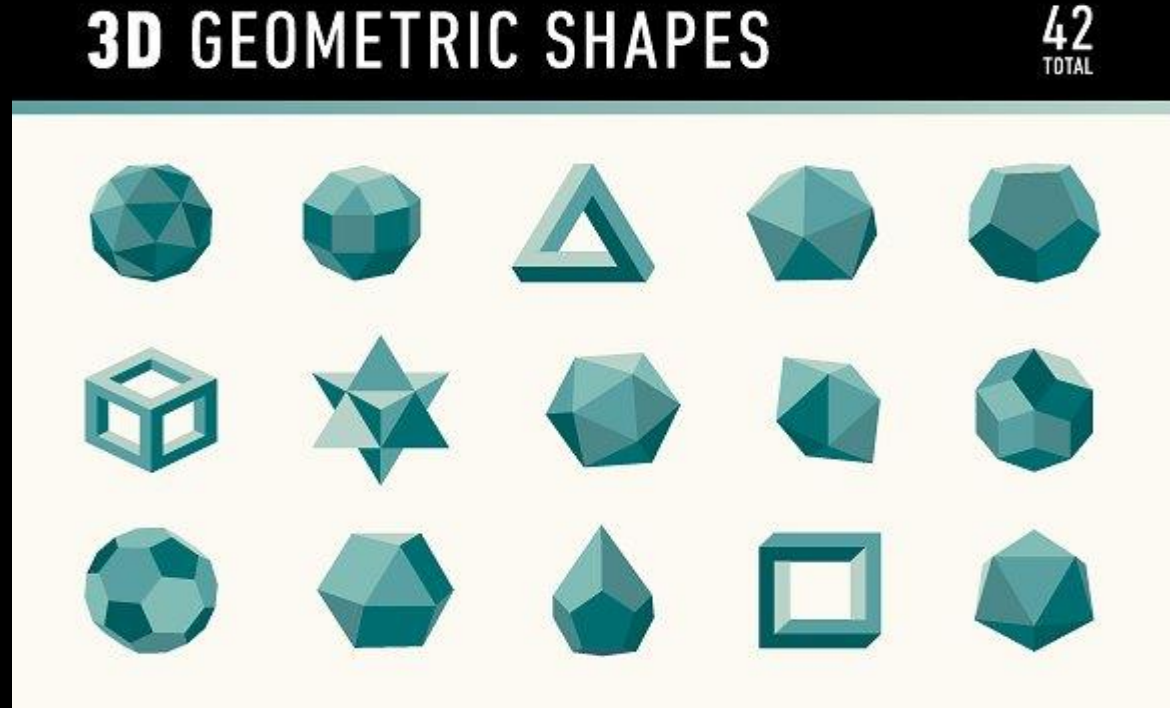
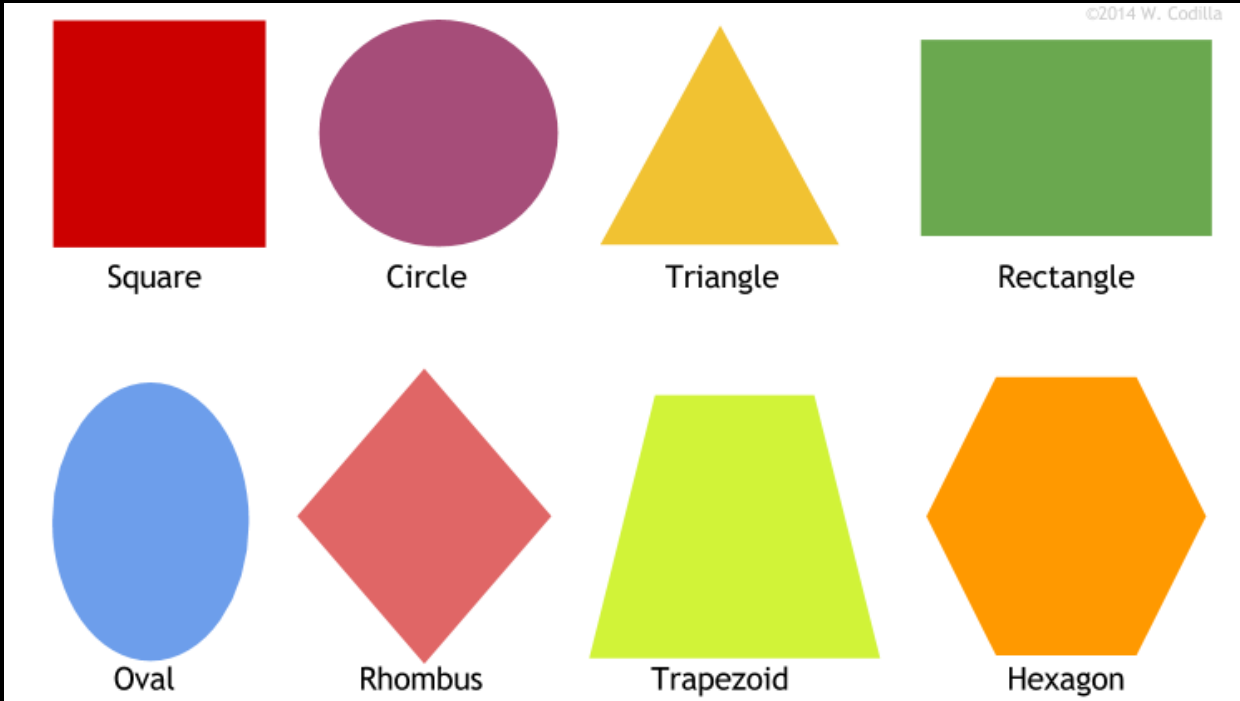

Let's get this over with right away.



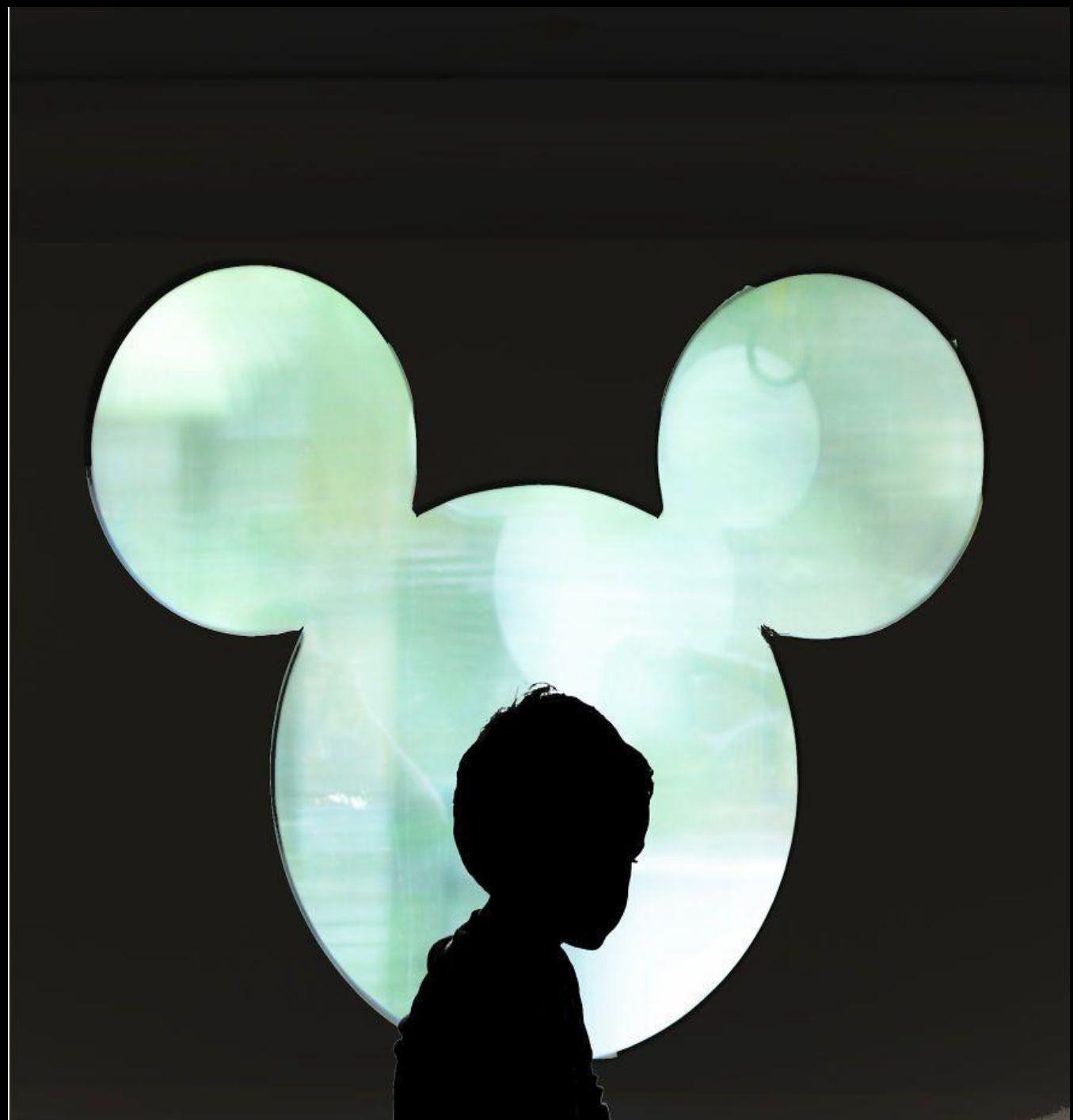
**Shape =**  
2D (flat) object.  
Geometrical & Organic

**Form =**  
3D object in a space (shows  
more than one side)

# Using Shape



Find an object / subject  
that is flat when you  
photograph it  
straight on.



# Using Shape

Even if the object is 3D in the real world, photographing it straight on, above, or below gives it a sense of flatness.

*If the objects look like they are paper cut-outs, that's a great example of shape!*



# Using Form



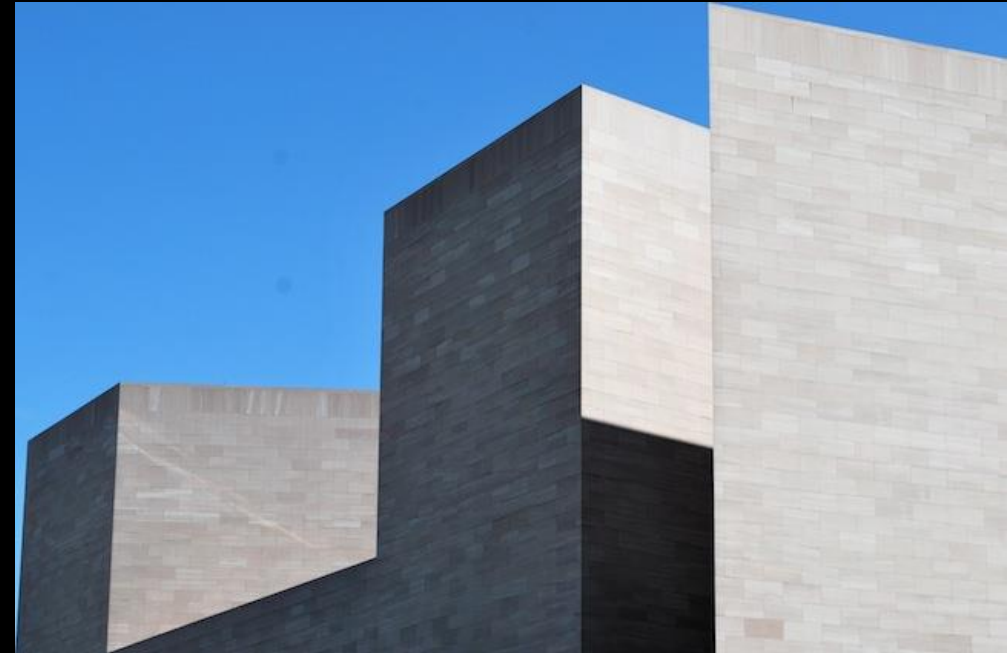
Find an object / subject that shows more than one side when you photograph it.



# Using Form

Buildings and objects  
that have sides are  
easiest to photograph  
as form.

*If the object forms a  
shadow, that is a good  
example of form!*
